Thank you for your inquiry into the Teen Association of Model Railroading. We hope that the TAMR will be right for you. The information we have here should answer any questions you have about us. If not, please feel free to contact me for further information.

WHAT IS THE TAMR?

The TAMR is an organization which is, as its name implies, an association of teens and young people who have an interest in the different phases of model railroading or railfanning. This organization was founded in 1963 and has been active since then by helping young modelers and railfans with their hobby.

WHY SHOULD YOU JOIN?

We provide many services to you, the modeller or railfan as a member. The main thing is our publication, the Hotbox, which is issued every other month and contains articles of interest to everyone. Member's layouts are described, techniques are presented in a manner so that the novice or pro will understand them. The main thing, however, is that the Hotbox is written by our members for our members. We encourage every member to submit articles and tips, as well as tales of their railfanning expeditions or for that matter anything that you feel will be of interest to the rest of the membership or that would make enjoyable reading.

We hold elections for various offices in the TAMR, such as President and Secretary. You may thus run or nominate someone to run for these offices. There are other elected or appointed officals that take care of advertising or photo-exchange committies. In short, there are many ways to get involved in this organization if you are prone to do so. By getting involved you not only help yourself but all are other members reap the rewards of your accomplishments as well.

OUR ANNUAL CONVENTION

Each year a convention is held in a location such that many of the members can go to it. It is a great time to meet other members of the TAMR and participate in the fun times that accompany each convention at little cost.
