

**EXAMPLE:** 

This means that John is in his third year with the TAMR (hence the "3" after his name) and is an associate member. Were there no (A) after his years with the TAMR, John would be presumed to be a regular member. John models in HO scale, has between 151 and 200 feet of track, models in the time period between 1950 to the present (1969), trades passes, likes steam, diesel, freight, and passenger operations, welcomes visitors unconditionally, and belongs to the NMRA (National Model Railroad Association, Inc.).
